RESOLUTION NUMBER 23-22

ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,000,000; AND AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE BUDGET FOR AN INCREASE IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 BUDGET OF \$3,000,000 IN REVENUE AND \$400,000 IN RELATED EXPENSE APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS, the County of Marin and the Richardson Bay Regional Agency (RBRA) constantly strive to seek solutions for the unhoused population in Marin, and

WHEREAS, the RBRA has particular concern for the unhoused population who live on the water on Richardson Bay, and

WHEREAS, RBRA worked in close coordination with Senator McGuire to apply for funds to address this issue, available through the State budget surplus; and

WHEREAS, the funding request allowed for great flexibility in how the funds are allocated to achieving the overarching goal of providing housing assistance; and

WHEREAS, for the balance of the 2023 fiscal year, expenses for case management, housing location, temporary housing support, staff training and other costs may reach \$400,000,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Richardson Bay Regional Agency by adoption of this resolution hereby accepts grant funding of an additional \$3,000,000 from the State Department of Housing and Community Development, and authorizes Amendment No. 1 to its fiscal year 2022-23 budget for an increase of \$3,000,000 in revenue and \$400,000 in expense appropriations.
