### Vessel metrics.

### Significant events:

Three vessels were removed from the anchorage in the last month. Two were removed as Marine Debris and one was surrendered to the RBRA. One vessel was re-located outside of the Eel Grass Protection Zone to the Southern anchorage.

One new vessel arrived on the anchorage this month. Efforts are underway to remove the vessel as marine debris.

There are currently two visiting vessels in the southern reaches of the anchorage.

Continued coordination with Marin County Sheriff Marine Patrol, and new coordination efforts with Sausalito Police Department are bolstering efforts to reduce the number of vessels on the anchorage.
